We closely monitor the attendance of all our learners. Learner attendance, along with effective teaching, has the greatest influence of learner engagement and achievement. The Education and Training Act 2020 requires that all children must attend school regularly. The school expects parents to

• Notify the school if their child is going to be absent **and the reason why** by phone, text or email by 9:00am.

• Try to arrange appointments etc. outside school hours, in holidays, or at times that minimise the time out of school.

Work with the school to manage any attendance issues.

Our overall attendance rate has not yet returned to pre-covid levels and our aim is to have every learner achieve an attendance rate of 95% or higher.

Children with high absenteeism are less likely to succeed in their learning. If a child misses five school days each term, or one day a fortnight, they will miss the equivalent of one year of school.

Preparations for the School Play of 'The Wizard of Oz' are coming along nicely. Kelly will be in touch with individual parents with any costume requirements before then. On the night, students will need to be dropped off at the Hall at 4:45pm. We ask that parents return to the Hall for a 5:30pm start. We will hold a shared supper in the small hall following the play, so please bring a plate to share.








GQLFNZ Year 7 and 8 Golf Competition Friday 15th of September
